Born in what is now Etiwanda, Calif., Jan. 25, 1884, Mrs. Watson came to the Littlerock community with her husband William Sinclair and two children in 1910. The couple had two additional children born in the south Valley community where the Sinclairs were

early orchardists.

Following the death of Mr. Sinclair, Mrs. Watson wed O. D. Watson in 1937. She was one of the first Los Angeles County Librarians to keep her library's books in a building other than a home, during those early days. Later, as Postmaster Delle Watson, she served her community's Post Office for five years.

Mrs. Watson died Dec. 18 in Lancaster after a lengthy illness.

Three of her four children survive their mother: Mrs. Gladys Bollman, president of the Littlerock Chamber of Commerce; Bill Sinclair of Littlerock; and Mrs. Genevieve Ryals of Long Beach; There are six grandchildren, 19-greatgrandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren.
