Funeral services for Farel A. Wykoff, 77, were held Saturday, Oct. 5, in the Chapel of the Valley by the Rev. Robert W. Ross of the Palmdale First Presbyterian Church. Interment followed in Desert Lawn Memorial Park.

A resident of Palmdale for 46 years, Mr. Wykoff was a veteran of World War I service with the U.S. Navy and saw service in France. He also was a Los Angeles County employee for 15 years prior to his retirement. He was born Jan. 20, 1897, in Nebraska, and died Oct. 3, in Palmdale.

He was a charter member of Palmdale VFW Post 3225, and a member of the Palmdale Fin and Feather Club.
