

Llano Rancher Is Taken in Death Sunday, June 13th

Clarkson Hughes Lockard To Be Buried Today

Clarkson Hughes Lockard, for many years a rancher residing in the Llano district, died at his home Sunday, June 13, after an illness of a few weeks with heart trouble. Mr. Lockard's ranch, on which he and his wife had lived for about fourteen years, is about one mile east of the Harris Store, Llano.

His wife, Mrs. Mary B. Lockard, and a sister, Mrs. H. A. Marvin, of San Bernardino, were at his bedside at the time of his death.

He was born in Schomberg, Canada, April 3, 1863, so was 74 years of age. He had lived in California about fifty years.

Christian Science burial services will be held for him this afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at Mumaw's Funeral Chapel in Lancaster, with burial at the Lancaster Cemetery. Mrs. C. C. Birch will be the reader for the services.
