

Aged Man Found Dead in His Cabin, Bellevue District

**Danforth Southwell Recently Moved
Here for Health**

Danforth Southwell, 79 years of age, was found dead in his cabin 1¼ miles south of the Bellevue School last Friday, he evidently having been dead about two days. Mr. Southwell had lived there only about three months, having moved there from Kentucky Springs, his home for the past fifteen years, on account of his health. He was found by neighbors at the side of his bed, dressed in pajamas.

Funeral services were held at Mumaw's Funeral Chapel at 9:00 Monday morning, with burial in the Lancaster Cemetery. Earl Longwell of Lancaster officiated.

Mr. Southwell was born September 5, 1858, in Saugatuck, Mich. He was a carpenter by trade. One son, Edward H. Southwell, 2503 Panorama Terrace, Los Angeles, survives.
