

Aged Belleview Resident Found Dead at Ranch

**Charles Carl Luebke To Be Buried
Saturday Afternoon in Lancaster**

Funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon at 3:00 o'clock at the Episcopal Church in Lancaster, for Charles Carl Luebke, 73-year-old Belleview resident who was found dead at his home Tuesday. Rev. Boyd Parker will officiate, the Odd Fellows will have a part in the services, and burial will be in the Lancaster Cemetery. Mumaw's are in charge.

Mr. Luebke's daughter, Mrs. Albert Schultz, found his body on the floor of their ranch home when she returned from a trip to Lancaster about 2:30 o'clock Tuesday afternoon. She had been away from home since 9:30 that morning, so death had occurred between that time. Mr. Luebke had been troubled lately with high blood pressure.

Mr. Luebke was a native of Hamburg, Germany, but had lived in the United States fifty-five years. He came to California and to his Antelope Valley ranch nineteen years ago. He was a blacksmith by trade. His wife preceded him in death about five years ago. Two daughters and two sons survive.
