

Elmer C. Lancey Is Buried in Lancaster Monday, May 8

The body of Elmer E. Lancey, aged Antelope Valley rancher, was found on the bed in his cabin at the ranch thirty miles west of Lancaster, last Saturday. Mr. Lancey had evidently been dead for several days, as he had not been seen by neighbors since the preceding Monday. Death was caused by a heart ailment and he had been ailing for quite a while, it is reported.

Funeral services were held Monday, May 9, at Mumaw's Funeral Chapel in Lancaster, with Rev. Boyd Parker officiating. Burial was in the Lancaster Cemetery. No surviving relatives could be located.

Gus Hendrickson and Mrs. Eddie Bittick, neighbors, discovered the deceased man Saturday, when they broke into his house to investigate his absence from his ranch activities.
