

Guy Moore, Former Lancaster Restaurant Man, Dies Sunday

Buried Yesterday—Formerly Owned Squeeze Inn Cafe

The death of Guy Moore, former Lancaster restaurant man, occurred early Sunday morning, July 3, at the Lancaster Community Hospital, following a heart attack. Mr. Moore had been in ill health for two or three years and his death was not unexpected.

Funeral services were held Wednesday morning at 10:00 o'clock at the Mumaw Funeral Home Chapel, with Rev. Boyd Parker officiating. Interment was in the Lancaster Cemetery.

Mr. Moore was 52 years of age at the time of his death, having been born October 3, 1884, at Memphis, Tennessee. He had lived in California about 30 years, and in Lancaster 10. He was a cook by trade, and after coming to Lancaster operated the Squeeze Inn Cafe for several years.

His wife, Wava May Moore, and their two children, Irene, a Junior College student, and Tom, survive. The Moore home is at 1038 Herald St., Lancaster.
