Services Held For Rose Ann Miller Monday Morning

Funeral services for Mrs. Rose Ann Miller, 50, who was found dead at her home in Palmdale early Thursday, October 23, were held at the Mumaw Chapel in Lancaster Monday morning at 11 o'clock, with Rev. Prince of the Lancaster Community M. E. Church officiating.

Mrs. Miller was well known in Lancaster and Palmdale, having resided here for a number of years.

Goodwin W. Mullins discovered that Mrs. Miller was dead when he tried to awaken her about 6 a.m. on Thursday, following a party held at her home the previous night. Deputies, who were called at the home after Dr. Snook had examined the body, reported that they found a box of sleeping tablets near the bed. It is believed she accidently took an overdose of the tablets, which had been left at her home by her mother in 1945.

Survivors include her mother, Mrs. Mary Hass of Los Angeles; a sister, Mrs. Florence Woodruff of Los Angeles and a brother, Frank T. Baer of South Gate. Interment was in Lancaster Cemetery.
