

Funeral Held for Littlerock Man, William Fishell

LITTLE ROCK—William David Fishell, 67, was buried in Lancaster Monday afternoon following his Thanksgiving Day death. He had been in poor health for two months.

Fishell, a resident of 8102 Ave. T, Littlerock, was employed as a truck driver. Rev. George Riffle of the Littlerock Community Bible Church conducted the services. Lancaster Elks also participated.

Born in Houston, Minn., on Nov. 24, 1887, he served in the first World War, holding the rank of sergeant.

Besides his wife Charlene, he leaves three sons, Richard, Billy Lee and Robert L., and a daughter Margie, all of Littlerock. A sister, Mrs. Ella Sodergren of Mitchell, South Dakota, also survives him.

Fishell came to the Antelope Valley in 1951.
