

Verrieur Funeral Rites Tomorrow

Henry Oza Verrieur, 62, long-time resident and businessman in Antelope Valley, died Tuesday at the age of 62 in Los Angeles.

Death resulted from an illness of four months.

Mr. Verrieur, who resided at 14409 Beech, was a native of Central Falls, Rhode Island. He first came to Antelope Valley in 1936 as a farmer, and more recently operated the Verrieur Nursery at Date and Lancaster Blvd.

Mr. Verrieur was a member of Lancaster Elks Lodge 1625, and officers of that organization will conduct a special memorial service in his honor at Mumaw Funeral Home today (Thursday) at 1 a.m.

Rosary will be said for Mr. Verrieur at the mortuary today (Thursday) at 8 p.m., and a requiem mass will be said tomorrow morning at 9 o'clock at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Lancaster. Interment will be at Lancaster Cemetery.

He leaves his widow, Amelia of Lancaster; and two daughters Florence M. Chilcott of Lancaster and Coralea A. Drescher of Topeka, Kansas.
