

Requiem High Mass Set for Victim of Fall From Ladder

Requiem high mass is set for 9 o'clock this morning at Sacred Heart Church, Lancaster, for Vincent Stanley Goransky, 51, of 44138 Peach Ave., Lancaster.

Mr. Goransky died Jan. 6 at Queen of Angeles Hospital, Los Angeles, where he was taken after being injured in a fall from a ladder at Machinery Overhaul

Company at Palmdale Airport Jan. 4.

The Rev. Charles Kennedy will be the celebrant and the adult choir will sing responses to the Mass. Rosary was recited last night at Mumaw Chapel.
