

# **Anna G. Branam Services Held**

Anna Georgia Branam, 78, died at her home, 42438 27th W., Lancaster, on Sunday, Jan. 21.

Funeral services were held at Assembly of God Church at 10 a.m. Wednesday, with Rev. Harold A. Pegg and Rev. Fred Cottriel officiating. Burial was at Lancaster Cemetery.

Mrs. Branam was born in Rodon, Sweden, and came to the United States in 1905. She was engaged in nursing and missionary work, prior to moving to California in 1912.
