

Hanna Guenther Services Today

A resident of Antelope Valley for more than half a century, Mrs. Hanna Marie Guenther, 81, died at her 938 E. Ave. R residence in Palmdale Sunday after a lingering illness.

Funeral services are to be conducted today at 3 p.m. at the Mumaw Funeral Home, Rev. John Springer of the First Presbyterian Church of Palmdale in charge. Burial will be in Lancaster Cemetery.

Mrs. Gunether was born in Milwaukee, Wisc. June 21, 1886 and came to Antelope Valley in 1914. She had been married to August William Guenther of Milwaukee, who died Mar. 11, 1949.

After coming to Antelope Valley, they homesteaded in Valyermo, where the St. Andrews Priory is now located, and later moved to Palmdale in 1929.

Mrs. Guenther is survived by two daughters, Dorothy B. Jones of Lancaster and Cora M. Moulton of Palmdale; five grandchildren, Donna Jezek of Fountain Valley, Owen Moulton of Bakersfield, Clifford Moulton of Hawaii, Dean Moulton of Georgia and Ted Jones of Whittier; and 11 great grandchildren.
