Gabriel Gabrielson, 21-year old Lancaster boy attending the University of California at Davis, was instantly killed last Friday in a head on collision between two automobiles near Davis. Gabrielson was the only one killed in the accident when eleven others were injured, some of them seriously. So great was the force of the collision that wreckage was strewn over the highway for a distance of fifty yards.
