Rites Conducted

Funeral services for Lewis A. Bones, 83, well-known Antelope Valley rancher, were conducted Mar. 30 in the Chapel of the Valley. Interment followed in Palmdale District Cemetery.

Mr. Bones who died Mar. 27 in Lancaster, was born May 4, 1886, in Los Angeles, and had ranched in the valley for 65 years prior to his retirement.

He married the former Florence Chapin, Nov. 21, 1938, in Las Vegas, Nev. His widow survives in the family home, 3810 E. Ave. V, Palmdale.
