

Marion Wright services set

Marion Wesley Wright Sr., a resident of Antelope Valley for more than a quarter of a century, died Nov. 5 in the Veterans Hospital in Sepulveda. He was 61 and lived in Lancaster.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday at 11 a.m. at the Mumaw Funeral Home, officers of Lancaster BPOE Lodge No. 1625 conducting the rites and burial in the Palmdale Cemetery.

Mr. Wright, who had been a building contractor, was a native of Texas, born Aug. 7, 1915.

He was a veteran of World War II, serving as a carpenters mate third class, USNR.
