# Funeral Services Held for John Deo

Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon at the Community Presbyterian church for John Deo, aged county road worker, who died last Friday morning from a second stroke of paralysis. The Rev. Harvey A. Hood, pastor of the church, officiated and spoke of the many good things he had heard regarding Mr. Deo.

Interment was in the Palmdale cemetery. Fellow county road employes were the pallbearers. A number of floral offerings were presented by friends.

The widow collapsed just after the services while on the way to the cemetery. Dr. F. P. Brockett, the attending physician, reported the first of the week that she was recovering.

Mr. Deo was born in 1864. He passed his early life in Michigan and was married there. Later with his wife he lived for some time in Canada. They had been residents of Palmdale five years.

Mr. Deo is survived by the widow and a brother.
