Funeral services for Leslie Sword Lightner, 65, prominent Acton resident, were conducted Feb. 8 at Chapel of the Valley Mortuary Chapel in Palmdale, with the Rev. Ray C. Krug, pastor of the Community Presbyterian Church officiating.
