

Trent Andrejcik rites today

Stricken while playing basketball at Brigham Young University April 3, Trent Charles Andrejcik of Palmdale was taken to the Utah Valley Hospital in Provo, Utah, where he was pronounced dead. He was 23.

Funeral services will be held today, April 8, at 10 a.m. at Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints Palmdale Stake Lodge, 2120 E. Ave. R, Palmdale, with Bishop Tom Jay of the Palmdale First Ward, Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, the officiant. Interment will be in Desert Lawn Memorial Park, Halley-Olsen Funeral Chapel of Palmdale in charge of arrangements.

Mr. Andrejcik was born in Lancaster Oct.

27, 1958, and had lived here all of his life.

He attended both Palmdale High School and Antelope Valley College where he was a member of the basketball teams. A student at Brigham Young University at the time of his death, he was also a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, priest in Aaronic Priesthood.

Mr. Andrejcik is survived by his parents, Andrew and Wilda Andrejcik of Palmdale; three sisters, Debra and Tamara Andrejcik of Palmdale and Janet Strong of Orem, Utah; a brother, Kirk Andrejcik of Glendale; and his grandmother, Ruby Nielsen of Palmdale.
