

Longtime Palmdale Postmaster, Mrs. Genevieve Frahm, 74, Dies

Services will be held at 10 a.m., Monday, Sept. 30, at the Mumaw Mortuary for Mrs. Genevieve Frahm, 74, longtime Palmdale postmaster who died

at her home, 38435 12th St. East, the morning of Sept. 27. She was found by her sister, Mrs. Straud McBride Sr., who lived next door.

Mrs. Frahm, who was preceded in death by her husband Richard, came to Antelope Valley in 1911 as a bride. She and her husband, along with Mrs. McBride Sr., operated the Cottage Hotel on 8th St. East near where Steve's Trading Post's old building now stands.

She was a native daughter,

born in San Francisco on Oct. 8, 1889. She served as the postmaster from July, 1919, until Oct. 31, 1959.
