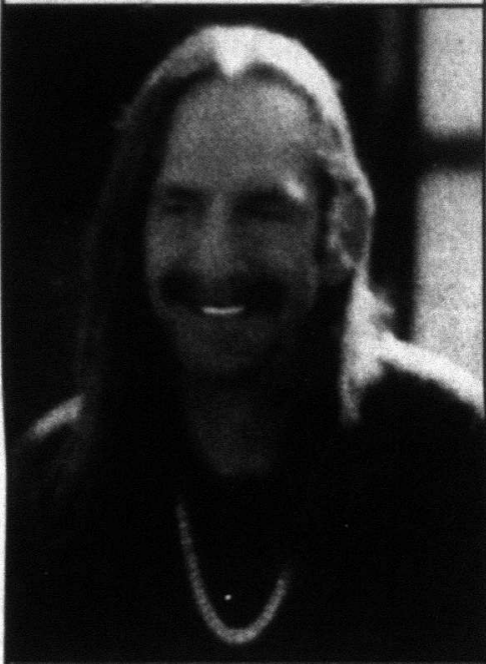


HESSELGRAVE, Michael Scott
