Fred H. Page Found Dead Monday at Home in Palmdale

Funeral Services Today—Burial in Local Cemetery

Fred H. Page, local resident of several years, was found dead in his home about noon last Monday, December 16th, when neighbors became worried over not seeing any activity about his place. Death resulted from heart failure, and apparently occurred during the preceding night.

Shuffleton, a neighbor, failed to see smoke coming out of his chimney Monday morning, she investigated and found him dead in bed. Officers and the doctor were notified.

The deceased had worked for several years, until lately, for the county yards here. He is survived by his daughter, Mrs. Martin Monia, well known in Palmdale, who now lives at the Morrison Dairy in Lancaster.
