
Henry Burre Dies Suddenly of Stroke —Burial Tomorrow

Funeral services are to be held Friday afternoon at 2:00 at Mumaw's Funeral Home chapel in Lancaster for Henry Burre, 74 year-old Route 2, Lancaster, rancher who died of a stroke Monday afternoon, February 7th. Rev. Boyd Parker of the St. Paul Episcopal Church, will officiate. Burial will be at the Lancaster Cemetery.

Mr. Burre was found unconscious in bed by his sister, Mrs. Bertha Kerris, 769 Cedar St., Lancaster, when she called at his place Monday. She called for Mumaw's ambulance, but Mr. Burre died almost immediately.

He had lived since 1925 on his ranch near the Avon Ranch, southwest of Lancaster. Mr. Burre was born October 29, 1863, at Vincennes, Ind. He was a carpenter by trade.

His wife died several years ago. Their six daughters survive, three living in Los Angeles and three in the East.
