

Peter Schwab Dies at Home In Lancaster

Funeral Services Wednesday Morning

Peter Schwab, for many years custodian of the County Building in Lancaster, and a long-time resident of the Valley, died early Monday morning at his home at 1220 Elm Ave., Lancaster. Funeral services were arranged for Wednesday morning, November 23, at Mumaw's Funeral Chapel, with burial in the Lancaster Cemetery. Masonic services were to be conducted, with Rev. Boyd Parker assisting, and members of the I.O.O.F. assisting as pallbearers.

Mr. Schwab was 84 years, 11 months, and 9 days of age, having been born December 12, 1853, in Cincinnati, Ohio. He had been a California resident forty years, and had lived in Lancaster twenty-three years. He was a cement contractor by trade, and twelve years ago was appointed as custodian of the County Building in Lancaster. He was a member of the Lancaster Lodge No. 437, A.F. and A.M.; Lancaster Lodge No. 441, I.O.O.F.; Sunshine Chapter No. 327, O.E.S.; and Rebekah Lodge No. 196. He had been a hard worker throughout his entire life, and was a well-liked and respected citizen.

His widow, Mrs. Anna Rose Schwab, and their two sons, Christy and Irvin Schwab, all of Lancaster, survive.
