Real Estate Man Richard G. Lee Funeral Saturday

Requiem high mass was held Saturday, February 25, at 10:00 a.m. at Sacred Heart Church, Lancaster, for Richard Gilbert Lee, husband of Mrs. Gladys Lee of 43807 West 25th St., Lancaster. Mr. Lee died February 22 at the Antelope Valley District Hospital after a brief illness.

Rev. Father Charles K. Kennedy was the celebrant, and the children's choir sang the responses to the mass. Rosary was recited Friday evening.
