

Final Rites Held For Hugh Hargis

Funeral services for Hugh Hargis of Lancaster were held July 3 at the Emmerson-Olsen Chapel with Rev. William F. Wade and officers of the Loyal Order of the Moose conducting the rites. Members of the American Legion Post No. 311 were the pallbearers and were in charge of graveside services at Lancaster Cemetery.

Mr. Hargis, 74, who lived at 328 W. Nicobar, died June 30 in the Wadsworth Veterans Hospital in Los Angeles.

He was a native of Midell, Okla., born May 6, 1897 and came to Antelope Valley in 1928.

A retired farmer, Mr. Hargis was a member of American Legion Post No. 311 and the Loyal Order of the Moose, Lancaster Lodge 1926. He was a veteran of World War I.

Surviving are a brother, Bill Hargis of Pauls Valley, Okla.; sister, Lulu Clement of Winnewood, Okla.; and a nephew, Lee Clement of Lancaster. His wife, Florence, died Aug. 8, 1969.
