

# **Charles Scates Rites Slated**

Funeral services for Charles Edward Scates, a 79-year-old man who had lived in Antelope Valley since the age of 13, were scheduled for 11 a.m. morning at Faith Bible Church in Lancaster.

Interment was to follow in the family plot in Lancaster Cemetery.

Mr. Scates, born Jan. 22, 1893, in Topeka, Kan., had lived at 44826 E. 5th St., Lancaster. He died there Saturday following a sudden illness.

Mr. Scates was a retired water well driller and had moved to California in 1905 and a year later took up residence in Antelope Valley.
