
FUNERAL SERVICES FOR PETRONILO GALINDO ARE HELD MONDAY MORNING

Funeral services for Petronilo (Pedro) Galindo, well known in Palmdale and at one time an employe of the Southern Pacific here, were held at the local section houses Monday morning. Galindo was injured Sunday, July 1, while working on the Palm ranch when a wheelbarrow loaded with rocks overturned on him and caused a serious abdominal rupture. Following treatment by Dr. H. S. Savage of Lancaster, Galindo was removed to the General hospital in Los Angeles. He died July 4.

Petronilo Galindo has been a resident of Palmdale for over ten years and was well liked by many residents here. Floral remembrances were piled high about the coffin. Burial took place at Lancaster cemetery. While his exact age is not known, Galindo was thought to be about fifty.
