Funeral Services Held for Pioneer

Funeral services for Mrs. Max Godde, who for nearly forty years lived in the foothills region near Quartz hill, were held last Thursday morning at 10 o'clock at the Sacred Heart church in Lancaster when a requiem mass was conducted by Rev. C. K. Kennedy. Interment was in Lancaster cemetery.

Beautiful floral pieces and the large number attending the funeral and filling the church both in quantity give evidence to the high regard in which the pioneer woman was held throughout the valley. Mrs. Godde was a devout member of the altar society of the Sacred Heart church.
