

Carmen Rosas Myrick

The rosary will be recited tonight at 7:30 at St. Mary's Catholic Church, Palmdale, followed by requiem mass Saturday, Nov. 20 at 11 a.m. for Carmen Rosas Myrick, 90, of Palmdale.

Friends may pay their respects from 3 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. today at Chapel of the Valley Mortuary, Palmdale, which is in charge of arrangements. The Rev. Michael Moran will officiate at the services, followed by interment in Palmdale District Cemetery.

A 60-year resident of Antelope Valley and a homemaker, Mrs. Myrick was born July 16, 1892 in Mexico. She was a member of St. Mary's Church, a lifetime member of the Latin American Club and a member of the Palmdale

PTA. She worked at Polaris Air Field (now Mira Loma) during World War II. She loved to garden and crochet and was an expert cook. She died Nov. 17 in Palmdale, preceded by her husband, Thomas, who died May 10, 1979.
