
H. P. Schoeller Dies After Heart Attack

CHINO, July 2—H. P. Schoeller Sr., 66, pioneer Antelope Valley resident and long-time official of the Palmdale Irrigation District died here today at the California Institution for Men. Coronary occlusion was given as the cause of death.

Mr. Schoeller first settled in Antelope Valley in 1912. In the early twenties he worked for a construction company while the Littlerock Dam was being built. Later he accepted a position with the Palmdale Irrigation District as engineer, and was secretary from 1933 to the time of his resignation July 3, 1947.

He is survived by his wife Ruth S. Schoeller and three sons, Phillip of Rio de Janeiro; Louis of New York City; H. P. Schoeller Jr. of Palmdale and three grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 5 p.m. at Mumaw Funeral Home in Lancaster. Interment will be in the Palmdale Cemetery.
