
Mrs. Reby Stanley Dies after Illness of Month and Half

Was Buried at Palmdale Sunday,
Rev. Wilson Officiating

Mrs. Reby Stanley, of Littlerock, passed into the Great Beyond last Thursday, November 14, 1935, after an illness of six weeks. Mrs. Stanley was well known in the Valley, having come here in 1915 from Kentucky, and lived in the vicinity of Littlerock and Palmdale for ten years.
