

Lyle W. Chapel services held

Graveside services for Lyle W. Chapel, 64, were conducted Friday, Apr. 4, in the Palmdale Distric Cemetery by the Rev. James Miley of St. Stephen's Lutheran Church of the Valley. The Chapel of the Valley was in charge of arrangements.

A resident of Palmdale for several years, Mr. Chapel was a federal postman before his retirement, and was a veteran of World War II, serving with the U.S. Army. He was born Feb. 17, 1911, in N. Dakota, and died April 1 in Palmdale.
